1. SAFETY

1.1. GENERAL SAFETY

- ✓ Locate the back panel in a suitable working area.
- ✓ Keep the back panel clean and tidy in accordance with good workshop practice.
- Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the working area.
- ✓ Take care when assembling in case of sharp edges, wear protective gloves.
- **DO NOT** use the back panel for any purpose other than that for which it is designed.
- DO NOT get the back panel wet or use in damp or wet locations or areas where there is condensation.
- DO NOT clean the back panel with any solvents which may damage the surface.

Note: The mounting of this product to the wall, will require assistance from another person.

2. INTRODUCTION



- Two door floor and wall cabinets feature perforated pegboard panels on the inside of the doors.



5. ASSEMBLY

- 5.1. Seek assistance from another person to mount back panel on the wall.
- 5.2. Using the back panel as a guide, drill a 12mm hole into the wall.
 - Note: The fixing holes should be horizontal and the returned edge touches the wall.
- 5.3. Insert the wall fixing, fit the washers and nut and do up. Repeat for the other three fixings. Ensure the back panel is securely fixed to the wall.
