Insulated Shipping Container Liner Assembly Instructions

- 1. Check all parts are present:
 - 2 side wall panels
 - 2 ceiling panel
 - 1 roll of joining tape
 - Floor liner (if included)
- 2. Make sure that the walls, roof, and floor on the inside of the container are completely dry and clean. This can be done with a brush.
- 3. Take one wall section and start fixing the liner from the centre of the back wall then make your way forward until you get to the front door. Do **NOT** press the sheet into the corrugations, these help to insulate.
- 4. Repeat step 2 on the other walls.
- 5. Insulate the roof, this arrives in two rolls for ease of installation.
- 6. If a floor liner is included, finish by insulating the floor.
- 7. Make sure all edges and joints are completely sealed with the added silver foil joining tape.
- 8. Use a brush and press onto the liner to ensure it is fixed and secure on the wall.
- 9. You should now have a fully insulated shipping container.
