The Never Rust recycling bin is based on the metal 'Barnsley' litter bin and is widely used throughout the United Kingdom and is a popular choice with councils and local authorities. It is especially popular in coastal areas as Glass Fibre Composite (GFC) is unaffected by extreme temperature changes or by salt water so will therefore not corrode when located close to the sea. It is also environmentally friendly with 65% of its construction coming from renewable sources.

The bin features a coloured recycling aperture with WRAP iconography and can be grouped together to create a multi stream recycling point.

The unit features a front opening hinged door fitted with a budget lock as standard with the option to upgrade to a slam lock available. Slam lock is a stainless steel lock which is easily opened using a square T key and closes with a push of the door against a spring loaded boss.

Finishes & Colours

The GFC litter bins are available with a choice of either a textured, smooth or Victoriana finish.





Textured Finish - Uses PTX textured paint to give a rough finish not too dissimilar to sand paper and designed to prevent unwanted graffiti and posters being applied to the bin

Smooth Finish - Uses a smoother pseudo-cast iron finish with only a slight texture and no roughness.

Victoriana Finish - Uses the smooth finish with only a slight texture and no roughness with the addition of highlighted beading to give a classic Victorian style appearance. The Victoriana finish is a popular choice for heritage sites and town centres.





Ground Fixing Options



Set of 4 RAWL Bolts

The Middlesbrough litter bins are supplied with a predrilled base allowing secure ground fixing using RAWL bolts.



Ground Anchor Feet

Ground Anchor Feet enable a bin to be sited into freshly laid concrete. The feet are supplied loose with the bin and bolt to the bottom of a bin. Once the concrete cures the bin is secured in place.
